### **PRESIDENT TRUMP FIGHTS FOR ISRAEL AND JEWISH AMERICANS**

Since his election in 2016, President Trump has rebuilt and reinvigorated the United States-Israel relationship. After eight years of the Obama Administration that apologized for US policy in the Middle East, and produced for a time an anti-American Muslim Brotherhood regime in Egypt (a long-standing ally of both the US and Israel), US-Israeli relations reached an all-time low with the imposition of the Iran nuclear deal (known among the diplomatic set as the "Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action," or JCPOA). The deal placed Israel under eminent threat of nuclear attack from Iran, despite its claimed purpose of containing Iranian nuclear development. As the late Charles Krauthammer [observed](#), what the JCPOA actually did was *guarantee* Iran obtaining nukes, while *losing* forever the tough sanctions that had been in place on Iran. And even before the disastrous Iran deal, Democratic National Convention delegates in 2012 [booed](#) a vote to reinsert God in its platform and recognize Jerusalem as Israel's capital. But wondrously, Trump's election at least halted any further capitulations from Hillary Clinton and fellow Democrats, and in his four years in office, he could be on the way to becoming the most pro-Israel and pro-Jewish American president ever.

For starters, the president tore up the Iran deal. Then he moved the US Embassy in Israel to Jerusalem, formally recognizing it as Israel's capital, fulfilling his own campaign promise (and the [unfulfilled same promise](#) by former president, George W. Bush).

#### **ANTI-SEMITES IN CONGRESS ENABLED BY DEMOCRATS**

In the meantime, radical first-term Representatives Ilhan Omar of Minnesota and Rashida Tlaib of Michigan wasted no time taking Democrats back to the anti-Israel attitude and rhetoric of the Obama years.

As Marc Thiessen [wrote](#) last year:

[Omar] has said “Israel has hypnotized the world” and declared her hope that Allah will “awaken the people and help them see the evil doings of Israel.” She supports a boycott of Israel, a country she has compared to Nazi Germany. She accused her House colleagues who support Israel of pushing “for allegiance to a foreign country.” And she has suggested support for Israel is “[all about the Benjamins](#).” (She later apologized for the last comment, but not all the others, before or since that one.)

House Speaker Nancy Pelosi [defended Omar’s](#) “allegiance-to-a-foreign-country” remark, saying, “I don’t believe it was intended in an anti-Semitic way.”

Like Omar, Tlaib has accused her colleagues of dual loyalty — a classic anti-Semitic trope — declaring “they forgot what country they represent.” She advocates a one-state solution, which means she opposes Israel’s existence. She wrote for Louis Farrakhan’s publication, The Final Call, which regularly publishes anti-Semitic screeds. And, according to the Anti-Defamation League, she invited a Palestinian activist to her swearing-in who has praised Hamas and Hezbollah and has equated Zionists with Nazis.

The two showed their true colors when they chose not to join a bipartisan congressional delegation to Israel earlier this month in favor of a trip organized by MITFAH, a rabidly anti-Semitic group that has accused Jews of using “the blood of Christians in the Jewish Passover,” published neo-Nazi propaganda questioning “the Jewish ‘Holocaust’ tale” in quotes and celebrated terrorists who murder Israeli children.

And, as though to prove Israel’s point, after being denied entry, the two lawmakers shared a cartoon on Instagram by an anti-Semitic cartoonist who placed second in Iran’s 2006 Holocaust cartoon contest.

The fact that Democrats tolerate, and even embrace, Omar and Tlaib is appalling.

So it’s crystal clear where the Democrat Party stands on Israel and Jewish Americans.

### **PRESIDENT TRUMP DEFENDS ISRAEL AND DETERS IRAN**

The contrast with the Trump Administration couldn’t be more stark. Just two weeks ago, Israel and the United Arab Emirates announced a breakthrough agreement, called the Abraham Accord, marking the UAE as only the third Arab nation to establish diplomatic relations with Israel. The deal, brokered by President Trump, may also gain more partners, as the president indicated he expected Saudi Arabia to [join it](#). Two weeks after its announcement, a US-Israeli delegation [flew](#) to the UAE in an inaugural passenger flight between the two countries, with Saudi Arabia permitting the use of its airspace for the Israeli El Al flight, also a first.

And during last week's Republican National Convention, Secretary of State Michael Pompeo addressed the gathering from Jerusalem, where he was [meeting](#) with Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, and later with UAE leaders on the Abraham Accord, and with other regional leaders. In his remarks, he noted President Trump's strike that killed the Iranian Revolutionary Guard General Qasem Soleimani, and that under "the president's determination and leadership, the ISIS caliphate is wiped out," including its "evil leader, Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi." Both of these ruthless terrorists were responsible for untold deaths and threats to US and Israeli security (as well as to other states across the region).

Even with the United States out of the disastrous Iran deal, the Trump Administration, recognizing Iran's enduring threat to Israel and other allies, continues to confront it, leading with the [reimposition of sanctions](#). On August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Secretary Pompeo sought to "snapback" the sanctions in force on Iran prior to the 2015 JCPOA. Unfortunately, he [found](#) in trying to reinstate them at the United Nations that Charles Krauthammer was also [prescient](#) in predicting that to be a tall order. But the perspectives and actions between radical, anti-God, and anti-semitic Democrats and Republicans, particularly the Trump Administration, are night-and-day different.

Democrats have sought as far back as 2012 to write God and Jerusalem as capital of Israel out of their platform. They, at best, tolerate, and at worst, enable anti-semitic "The Squad" members Ilhan Omar and Rashida Tlaib in the vilest stereotypes of Jews and hostility toward Israel.

### **PRESIDENT TRUMP KEEPS FAITH WITH ISRAEL**

President Trump promised during his 2016 campaign to leave the Iran nuclear deal, and in making good he kept faith with Israel. He bolstered that renewed confidence by fulfilling a 20-year old commitment from his most recent Republican predecessor – at last formally recognizing Jerusalem as Israel's "eternal capital." By taking out Iranian terrorist Soleimani and the ISIS caliphate, President Trump has shown both our Israeli allies and Jews at home that their lives will not be threatened or taken without the severest of consequences. By successfully bringing Israel and the UAE to the negotiating table, he has potentially initiated a process that will build its own momentum, perhaps with Saudi Arabia being next among Israel's new diplomatic partners. And by maintaining the military, diplomatic and economic pressure on Iran, he provides increasing incentive for other Arab states to turn away from the ayatollahs and toward peaceful relations with the US and Israel.

The president has also reinforced Israel's sovereignty and strengthened its hand against Iranian proxy Hezbollah and other terrorist groups, by [withdrawing US funding](#) from the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), signing the [Taylor Force Act](#) (suspending funding to the Palestinian Authority for subsidizing terrorism), and recognizing the Golan Heights as part of the state of Israel.

Upon President Trump's [signing](#) of the Golan Heights proclamation, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said, "Israel has never had a better friend than you."
