## Sample e-note for Catholics to send to fellow Catholics and pro-Life family, friends, neighbors and others

Hey Bob,

I wanted to write to you today with a quick note about the upcoming Georgia Senate runoff elections. Frankly, I'm really worried about America and our Catholic Church.

First, as a Catholic I am especially concerned that our religious liberty is what's literally at stake if the New Democrats take total control of our government. I know that might sound extreme, but I look around at what's already happening; the government restricting church attendance, governors and city officials closing church services, and even denying funeral services.
